JOB DESCRIPTION:

Deconstruction workers are responsible for systematically removing building materials and furnishings from existing homes and/or buildings for the purpose of resale and to make way for new construction. The work is performed using a variety of tools and supports such as wrecking bars, sledgehammers, axes, shovels, scaffolding, ladders and in some cases small vehicles such as bobcats or forklifts.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Baltimore City resident
- Able to pass a drug test
- Must be at least 18 yrs. of age or older
- 8th grade Math and Reading skills as measured by T.A.B.E.
- Valid MD. driver's license *highly preferred*, not required
- Ex-offender friendly, no sex crimes, will consider felony on case by case basis
- Personal or professional reference required for pre-pre-screen

- Ability to work in areas with environmental job site dust, as well as cold, hot and extreme temperatures
- Able to perform physical activities that require strenuous use of your arms and legs and movement of the whole body, such as climbing, balancing, walking, stooping, lifting up to 50 lbs., handling materials and working in confined spaces. Prior injuries will be aggravated
- Must have a strong desire to work in construction industry
